§ 128-1. Adoption of standards by reference.

The following New Jersey Department Health Model Codes are adopted by reference as part of the Health Code of the Borough of Swedesboro:

- A. Individual Sewage Disposal Systems Code of New Jersey of 1963.
- B. Swimming Pool Code of New Jersey of 1970.
- C. Solid Waste Code of New Jersey of 1959.¹
- D. Individual and Semi-Public Water Supply Code of New Jersey of 1966.
- E. New Jersey State Housing Code of 1962.

§ 128-2. Copies on file.

Three (3) copies of each of said codes are to be filed in the office of the Secretary of the Board of Health of the Borough of Swedesboro, located at the Borough Clerk's Office of the Borough of Swedesboro, Borough Hall, Kings Highway, Swedesboro, New Jersey, and will be available for public inspection there on week-days during the business hours of 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. Said copies will remain on file in said office until final action is taken on this chapter for the use and examination by the public.

§ 128-3. Violations and penalties.²

Pursuant to the authority granted by N.J.S.A. 26:3-70, each violation of any of said codes shall, upon conviction thereof, subject the violator to a fine of not less than five dollars (\$5.) and not more than five hundred dollars (\$500.).
